The Malta Association of Public Health Medicine (MAPHM) condemns, without reservations, the horrendous

murder of Daphne Caruana Galizia last week and, on behalf of its members, offers its sincere condolences to

her family.

that these are also perceived by society to be functioning well. Malta has registered significant achievements
